Systems & Programs Optimization Console

Professional User Manual

This document provides official operating instructions, safety guidelines, and feature explanations for the Systems & Programs Optimization Console.

1. Introduction

The Systems & Programs Optimization Console is a Windows-based system management utility designed to monitor performance, manage startup applications, and safely remove unused software. It includes built-in protection mechanisms such as system restore point creation before changes are made.

2. Core Features

- Live CPU, RAM, and Disk monitoring dashboard
- Installed program inventory with usage detection
- Safe uninstall functionality
- Startup impact scoring and management
- Optional automatic system restore point creation
- CSV and PDF reporting capabilities

3. Using the Application

Launch the application and approve the Administrator permission request. The dashboard displays live system health statistics. Use the Installed Programs section to review applications and remove unused software. Use the Startup Applications section to disable or enable startup entries to improve boot time.

4. Startup Impact Levels

Impact Level	Description
High (Red)	May significantly slow system startup
Medium (Yellow)	Moderate impact on startup performance
Low (Green)	Minimal impact on startup

5. Safety & Protection

The application protects critical Windows components from removal. When enabled, a system restore point is created before uninstalling software or modifying startup entries. This allows safe rollback if needed.

6. Reporting & Exporting

Users can export installed program data in CSV format for spreadsheet analysis or generate a PDF report for documentation and auditing purposes.
